

FEND

OIL NUT BAY, THE CARIBBEAN

It's boat or helicopter only to reach the resort of Oil Nut Bay, hidden away on the eastern tip of Virgin Gorda. The dream draw is the Cliff Penthouse Suite, carved into the rock-face and boasting 1,334 square foot of Fendi Casa interiors (think slate-grey rugs emboased with that signature FF motif). Sliding glass walls open out to an infinity pool and huge double day-beds from which to absorb the azure panoruma. Emerge from your cocoon and there's access to the Beach Club, water sports, restaurants, spa treatments and an assortment of walking trails that stretch across the island. Sceen nights at Oil Nat Bay, from £2,785 a person half board in a Cliff Suite, including Virgin Atlantic flights from Gattsick, connecting flights and boat transfers, with Carrier (0161 492 1354; www.carrier.cu.uk).

KARL LAGERFELD SOFITEL SO SINGAPORE, SINGAPORE

For a slice of the Lagerfeld lifestyle, head East to the just-opened Sofitel So Singupore, whose Kurl-imagined 'Lion's Seal' emblem adorns door handles and bathrobes. An avid book collector, Lagerfeld has curated the shelves in an inviting library, La Bibliotek,

while the front-of-house team sport a monochrome uniform from the designer's own collection, Sadly, there's no sign of his feline friend Choupette, but you can keep up with her on Twitter via the iPhones and iPad Minis in each room, which can also be used to control everything from the lighting to the temperature.

CHANEL

PARK HYATT VIENNA, AUSTRIA

Paris may be Coco Chanel's beartland, but the sparkling new Park Hyatt Vienna, housed in an imposing former bank headquarters, pays homage to the designer at every turn. Located on the Am Hof square in the capital's fashionable Goldenes Quartier, the first Austrian Park Hyutt has named its cocktail corner Pearl, in tribute to Chanel's jewel of choice; and the Lounge's art deco interiors are modelled on her famous mirrored staircase at 31 Rue Cambon. The pièce de résistance? An underground 10,000-square-foot Arany Spa, whose gold mosaic-lined pool is carved into the former vault. 

THE ST REGIS NEW YORK, USA

Back in play after a dramatic renovation, the St Regis has expanded its King Cole Bar & Salon (birthplace of the Bloody Mary). But for conture lovers, it's the Dior Suite that is the big draw, Swaths of fabric in the label's signature 'whisper' grey and muted pink dress the space, and omate Louis XVI-esque furniture in the living-room nods to the Avenue Montaigne steller in Paris. Suite guests can also access the second floor of the Dior boutique on 57th Street, which will be opened exclusively for their visit.





PORTRAIT FIRENZE, ITALY

The latest edition in the Ferragamo family of hotels, Portrait Firenze sits on the banks of Florence's River Arno, where lucky guests can glimpse the Ponte Vecchio from their balcony. The boutique property offers 36 rooms and suites that celebrate the birth of Italian couture in the 1950s, with exquisite fabrics, dark hardwood floors, bathrooms chiselled from Carrara marble and an endless supply of Salvatore Ferragamo lotions and potions. There's no formal restaurant, but the hotel's excellent 'lifestyle team' can organise everything from a private gourmet walking tour through the city markets to wine tasting at an exclusive Tuscan vineyard.
